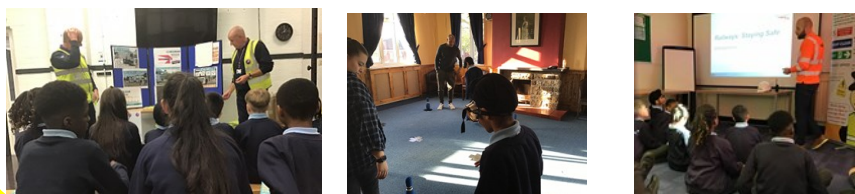
**Bonfire Night**
