

Numeracy:

Pupils will learn to use and apply skills based on their knowledge of place value to explore addition and subtraction. Children will also recognise, name and sort 2D and 3D shapes.

History:

Pupils will learn:

To investigate and identify a variety of homes today.

To investigate similarities and differences between homes

To explore homes built a long time ago and identify their features.

To find out what Victorian homes were like inside.

To identify and explore objects in a Victorian home and their uses.

To summarise and consolidate what we have found out about Victorian homes.

Phonics:

In their Phonics lessons, children will build on their understanding of Set 1 and 2 sounds, progressing to develop their knowledge of Set 3 sounds. They will use their knowledge to decode, blend and segment words. They will work on their ability to spell known sounds, their cursive handwriting and knowledge of 'real' and 'alien' words.

Literacy

Pupils will:

- Ask relevant questions, build vocabulary and participate in discussions, presentations, performances, role play, improvisations and debates.
- They will retell stories and consider their particular characteristics, discuss words meanings, lining new meanings to those already known, discuss the significance of the title and events, make inferences on the basis of what is being said and done, predict what might happen on the basis of what has been read so far and participate in discussion about what has been read to them.
- Children will compose a sentence orally before writing it, sequence sentences to form short narratives, re-read what they have written to check that it makes sense, discuss what they have written with the teacher or other pupils and read aloud their writing clearly enough to be heard by their peers and the teacher.

Art and Design:

Children will concentrate on the work of Andy Goldsworthy. They will learn:

To sort items by material and colour.

To use a variety of materials to create paths and walls.

To select materials and make spirals or circles.

To manipulate materials when creating sculptures.

To use reflections in art work.
